

## **TMU Thesis Scholarship Regulations**

- Article 1. To promote academic research and encourage publication of students' theses and dissertations, these regulations were established in accordance with TMU scholarship and grant regulations.
- Article 2. Any student who during their term of study at TMU publishes a paper in a journal indexed in SCI, SSCI, EI or A&HCI listing their affiliation with the university may apply for this award. The applicant shall be the first author and the tutor shall be the corresponding author.
- Article 3. Each applicant may submit up to three papers per year, and each article can only win an award once.
- Article 4. The amount of the student thesis scholarship equals half of the teacher's dissertation payment. If the thesis has two or more first authors, the same amount would be divided equally among these authors. However, first authors all being students of the University are excluded from the regulation. Applicants should submit an application form with offprints of related papers, gallery proofs, or letters of acceptance to the Office of Research and Development throughout the calendar year. If the total amount of the scholarships is beyond the budget, each amount shall be reduced proportionately.
- Article 5. Postdoctoral research fellows shall be awarded separately.
- Article 6. These regulations shall be implemented after Administrative Meeting inspection and approval.
